The funding will be provided to enterprises that meet the following requirements:

- 1. Enterprises/Projects with significant development impact:
 - Job creation/Retention: funding must create direct new jobs and/or retain existing ones. All the jobs created directly as a result of the funding must fall within the boundaries of the municipality.
 - Empowerment: funding must directly promote Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (BBBEE) as envisaged in the Broad Based Black Empowerment Act.
- 2. Funding/Support is granted for expansion of existing businesses.
- 3. Funding/Support limit will be based on the project VIABILITY.
